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| 19-Jan | What weighs more, a kilogram of lead or a kilogram of feathers? | They both weigh the same. |

| 2-Feb | A clock strikes ' 6 ' in 5 seconds. How long does it take to strike '12'? | 11 seconds. There is an interval of 1 second between each stroke. If the clock strikes 6 , there are 5 intervals. If the clock strikes 12 there are 11 intervals. |
| 9-Feb | A father is four times as old as his son. In 20 years he will be twice as old as his son. How old are father and son now? | The father is 40 son is 10. |
| 16-Feb | A frog is at the bottom of a 30 m well. Each day he summons enough energy for one 3 m leap up the well. Exhausted, he then hangs there for the rest of the day. At night, while he is asleep, he slips back 2 m . How many days does it take him to escape from the well? | 27 days |
| 23-Feb | At a family reunion were the following people: one grandfather, one grandmother, two fathers, two mothers, four children, three grandchildren, one brother, two sisters, two sons, two daughters, one father-inlaw, one mother-in-law, and one daughter-in-law. But not as many people attended as it sounds. How many were there, and who were they? | There were two little girls and a boy, their parents, and their father's parents, totalling seven people. |
| 1-Mar | Chopper charges $\$ 6$ to cut a wooden log into 2 pieces. How much will Chopper charge to cut a log into 4 pieces? | $\$ 18$ as it requires 3 cuts to make 4 pieces |
| 8-Mar | Dakin is standing behind Jan, and Jan is standing behind Dakin. How is this possible? | They are standing back to back. |
| 15-Mar | David is older than Dean. Susan is younger than David, but older than Jane. Tom is younger than Jane, but older than Dean. Jane is older than Dean but younger than Susan. Tom is not the youngest. Susan is not the oldest. Tom is younger than Susan and David. Who is the youngest? | Dean |
| 22-Mar | How can you double your money? | Look at it in font of a mirror. |
| 29-Mar | How can you make seven even? | Take away the letter "s". |
| 5-Apr | How do you file a nail? | Under the letter "n". |
| 12-Apr | How many CDs can you put into an empty CD case? | One, after that it is not empty anymore. |


| 19-Apr | If boiling water is poured into a thin wine glass and a thick drinking glass, which is more likely to crack? | Surprisingly enough, the thick glass is more likely to crack since glass is a poor conductor of heat. In a thin glass, the heat passes more quickly from the glass into the surrounding air, causing the glass to expand equally. When hot water is poured into a thick glass, the inner surface expands, but the outer surface does not. It is this extreme stress on the glass that causes it to crack. |
